- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 50B-7 reads as rewritten:
- 7 "§ 50B-7. Remedies not exclusive.
- 8 The remedies provided by this Chapter are not exclusive but are additional to (a) 9 remedies provided under Chapter 50 and elsewhere in the General Statutes.
- Any subsequent court order entered supersedes similar provisions related to child 10 (b)
- custody, child and spousal support, and possession of property issued under Chapter 50 or 11 Chapter 110 of the General Statutes supersedes similar provisions in protective orders issued 12
- 13 pursuant to this Chapter."
- SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to orders in 14 15 effect on or after that date.
