1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED		
2	AN ACT TO RESTORE LONGEVITY PAYMENTS FOR EDUCATORS.		
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
4	SECTION 1.(a) Section 9.1(d) of S.L. 2014-100 is repealed.		
5	SECTION 1.(b) For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, annual longevity payments for		
6	teachers and instructional support personnel shall be at the rate of one and one-half percent		
7	(1.5%) of base salary for 10 to 14 years of State service, two and twenty-five hundredths percent		
8	(2.25%) of base salary for 15 to 19 years of State service, three and twenty-five hundredths		
9	percent (3.25%) of base salary for 20 to 24 years of State service, and four and one-half percent		
10	(4.5%) of base salary for 25 or more years of State service. The longevity payment shall be paid		
11	in a lump sum once per year.		
12	<b>SECTION 1.(c)</b> For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, longevity payments for principals		
13	and assistant principals shall be as provided for State employees under the North Carolina Human		
14	Resources Ac	t.	
15	SE	<b>ECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Depart	ment of
16	Public Instruction for the 2023-2024 fiscal year the sum of one hundred forty million three		
17	hundred thousand dollars (\$140,300,000) in recurring funds to restore longevity payments for		
18	educators pursuant to this act.		
19	SE	<b>ECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2023.
