10	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:					
11	SECTION 1.(a) Section 2 of S.L. 2021-127 reads as rewritten:					
12	"SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, when ERS					
13	assessments resume and the Division of Child Development and Early Education (Division) is					
14	awarding quality rating improvement system (QRIS) "education points" to a licensed child care					
15	facility toward its star rating, if the percentage of lead teachers in the program required to meet					
16	the "rated licensed education requirements" criteria is set at seventy-five percent (75%) for the					
17	program to earn those "education points" toward the facility's star rating, the Division shall lower					
18	the seventy-five percent (75%) threshold to fifty percent (50%) of lead teachers through June 30,					
19	2023.<u>2026.</u>"					
20	SECTION 1.(b) Section 3 of S.L. 2021-127 reads as rewritten:					
21		DN 3. Section 1 of this act is effective when it becomes law and expires size				
22	after the date the Governor signs an executive order rescinding Executive Order No. 116,					
23	Declaration of a State of Emergency to Coordinate Response and Protective Actions to Prevent					
24	the Spread of COVID-19. June 30, 2024. Section 2 of this act is effective when it becomes law					
25	and expires June 30, 2023. 2026. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law."					
26	SECTION 2. The North Carolina Child Care Commission (Commission) shall					
27	complete recommendations for quality rating improvement system (QRIS/Star-Rating System)					
28	reform by March 31, 2024, and submit its QRIS reform recommendations to the Joint Legislative					
29	Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services before the 2024 Legislative Session begins.					
30	The Commission's QRIS reform recommendations shall include accreditations from national					
31	early childhood education (ECE) accreditation organizations as an alternative pathway for					
32	licensed child care programs to earn a star rating equivalent to each accreditation's standards,					
33	including accreditations from any of the following organizations:
