2 by rewriting the lines to read:

- 4 "c. The system depopulated after January 1, 2005, and the system ceased
- 5 operation no longer than 10 years prior to the current date.
- 6 d. At the time the system ceased operation, the system was in
- 7 compliance with an individual permit or a general permit issued
- 8 pursuant to G.S. 143-215.10C.
- 9 e. The Division of Water Resources issues an individual permit or
- 10 certificate of coverage under a general permit issued pursuant to G.S.
- 11 143-215.10G for operation of the system before any animals are
- 12 brought on the facility.
- 13 f. The permit for the animal waste management system does not allow
- 14 production, measured by steady state live weight, to exceed the
- 15 greatest steady state live weight previously permitted for the system
- 16 under G.S. 143-215.10C.
- 17 g. No component of the animal waste management system and swine
- 18 farm, other than an existing swine house or land application site,
- 19 shall be constructed on land that is located within the ~~10~~-year
- 20 floodplain. 100
- 21 h. The inactive animal waste management system was not closed using
- 22 the expenditure of public funds and was not closed pursuant to a
- 23 settlement agreement, court order, cost share agreement, or grant
- 24 condition."


