A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS
THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Council for Women, the sum of two million one hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$2,145,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two million one hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$2,145,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the prevention of domestic violence programs within the State to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$15,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year and \$15,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used for a grant-in-aid to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Inc.;
- (2) Each of the 66 domestic violence programs in operation on January 1, 1993, that offer services including, but not limited to, a 24-hour crisis line, community, education, victim advocacy, and support services shall receive a grant of \$30,000 for each fiscal year of the biennium to be used for program operation;
- (3) \$150,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year and \$150,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the development of new domestic violence programs. The Council for Women may award grants up to \$30,000 for new program development.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
