AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A SOUTHEAST

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A SOUTHEAST AGRICULTURAL MARKETING OFFICE AND TO REALLOCATE FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR AGRICULTURAL FACILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of one hundred fifty-one thousand nine hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$151,978) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred twenty-one thousand four hundred two dollars (\$121,402) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to establish and operate a Southeast Agricultural Marketing Office in Sampson County.

Sec. 2. Of the funds appropriated to the Department of Agriculture in Section 4 of Chapter 1044 of the 1991 Session Laws for the Southeastern Farmers' Market - Shipping Point Facility, the sum of ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) shall be used as a grant-in-aid to the Town of Roseboro for water and sewer services and the sum of nine hundred ten thousand dollars (\$910,000) shall be used as a grant-in-aid to Sampson County to be used for construction of a livestock sale facility.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
