2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA CAMP
3	PROGRAM.
4	Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H educational centers (camps) are owned by
5	the State, or deeded to an entity of the State, North Carolina State University; and
6	Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of
7	these facilities; and
8	Whereas, each year, these facilities provide educational and recreational
9	services to more than 10,000 North Carolina families representative of the State's
10	population; and
11	Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000
12	contributed by citizen volunteers; and
13	Whereas, the North Carolina Youth Development Department at North
14	Carolina State University needs funds to meet mandated safety, health and fire
15	compliance, and accessibility improvements to meet needs of the youth of North
16	Carolina; Now, therefore,
17	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
18	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
19	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars
20	(\$2,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used by North Carolina State University
21	for expenses relating to the mandated safety, health, and fire compliance and
22	accessibility requirements of its 4-H camp programs.
23	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
