A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE THE PERSONAL NEEDS
ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN DOMICILIARY CARE RESIDENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of four hundred sixty-nine
thousand eight hundred seventy-six dollars (\$469,876) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to

increase the personal needs allowance for domiciliary care residents receiving State-County Special Assistance for Adults from twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00) a month to thirty-one dollars (\$31.00) a month.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
