A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR JUVENILE INTENSIVE SERVICES, AS  
RECOMMENDED BY THE CHILD FATALITY TASK FORCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Juvenile Services Division, Judicial Department the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for intensive services for any juvenile who is under the protective supervision of the court, is on probation, or has attained aftercare status. The Division shall determine each juvenile's intensive services plan based on the needs of each juvenile. The plan may include substance abuse treatment, intensive family therapy, Family Preservation Services, or alternative residential placement in the community.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
