2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
3	STUDY THE NEED TO ESTABLISH A COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTIC IN
4	NORTH CAROLINA, AND TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study:
7	(a) The need and feasibility of establishing a college of chiropractic in this State;
8	and
9	(b) If a chiropractic college is found needed and its establishment feasible, the
10	best method of accomplishing that end, including the most advantageous and
11	economical placement of such a college within The University of North Carolina.
12	The University of North Carolina and its Board of Governors shall cooperate
13	fully with this study if the Legislative Research Commission undertakes it.
14	Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report of
15	the results of this study, including legislative recommendations, to the 1993 General
16	Assembly, Regular Session 1994, and shall make a final report to the 1995 General
17	Assembly.
18	Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative
19	Research Commission the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal
20	year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year.
21	Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
