Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding G.S. 113-202, the Marine Fisheries Commission shall not grant shellfish cultivation leases for areas in Core Sound.

- (b) For purposes of this act Core Sound is the body of water lying between Core Banks and the Carteret County mainland bounded on the northern end by a line from a point near Swash Inlet at 34° 58'50" N-76° 09'13" W and running 292° M to a point on Hog Island Reef at 35° 00'06" N-76° 14'52" W and on the southern end by a line from a point north of Bardens Inlet at 34° 38'16" N-76° 31'05" W running 6° M to a point at Marshallberg at 34° 43'07" N-76° 31'12" W.
- Sec. 2. This act does not prohibit the renewal or transfer of shellfish cultivation leases in Core Sound in accordance with G.S. 113-202 if the lease being renewed or transferred existed prior to or on the effective date of this act.
  - Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification and expires on July 1, 1995.
