A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE

INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA HOSPITALS AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by certain constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, of the capital improvement projects listed herein for each institution, and to authorize the financing of these said projects with funds available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, including patient receipts at the University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of such funds, but not including funds appropriated from the General Fund of the State. Funds authorized herein for the Renovation of Minges Coliseum are a reauthorized amount, superseding and replacing the prior amount established for such project by Chapter 1012 of the 1991 Session Laws. Patient receipts at the University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill may not be used to finance a capital improvement project authorized by this act, except the project described in Section 2, item 7 of this act.
