6	Section 1. G.S. 130A-55 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(23) To acquire by purchase, lease, gift, bequest, or devise, property to be
8 9	used for purposes that counties and cities can exercise under:  a. The Recreation Enabling Law, Article 18 of Chapter 160A of
10	<u>a.</u> The Recreation Enabling Law, Article 18 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes;
11	b. G.S. 160A-488, entitled 'Museums and arts programs.';
12	c. G.S. 160A-492, entitled 'Human relations, community action
13	and manpower development programs.'; and
14	d. G.S. 160A-497, entitled 'Senior citizens programs.'"
15	Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Riegelwood Sanitary District.
16	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
