May 11, 1993 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS PERMISSIBLE TO PREPARE AND SERVE FOOD AND BEVERAGES IN A GAZEBO OR OTHER STRUCTURE LOCATED OVER NONNAVIGABLE WATERS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 113A-107 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(g) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is permissible to prepare and serve food and beverages in a facility such as a gazebo, dock, or porch, whether enclosed or not, located over nonnavigable waters, provided that the facility complies with health and building laws. For purposes of this subsection, 'nonnavigable waters' 10 are those bodies of water that are partially enclosed and that have a depth at low tide of no more than 12 inches."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
