May 11, 1993 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN THE BODY OF A VICTIM OF A HOMICIDE IS FOUND IN NORTH CAROLINA, THAT FACT IS PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE 3 THAT THE HOMICIDE WAS COMMITTED IN NORTH CAROLINA. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. Article 13 of Chapter 15 of the General Statutes is amended by 6 7 adding a new section to read: "§ 15-133.1. Body of homicide victim found in North Carolina; prima facie 8 9 evidence. When the body of a person who died as a result of a homicide is found within this 10 State, that fact is **prima facie** evidence that the person died as a result of a homicide 11 committed within this State." 12 Sec. 2. The title of Article 13 of Chapter 15 of the General Statutes reads as 13 14 rewritten: "Venue. Venue and Jurisdiction." 15 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993. 16
