# 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR3 EXPANSION OF THE APPRENTICESHIP DIVISION.

4 Whereas, the 21st century will require fully qualified, skilled, and 5 knowledgeable workers; and

6 Whereas, the Department of Labor has 54 years of experience in establishing 7 and administering federally recognized and approved on-the-job and in-class training 8 programs for workers in a wide variety of technical skill areas; and

9 Whereas, this training must be sanctioned according to the standards set for 10 individual skill areas and approved by the federal government; and

Whereas, it is increasingly important that the providers of skills training recognize the necessity of preparing workers to have transferable talents and accreditations which will be available to them in their job-seeking throughout the United States of America; and

Whereas, training programs must begin with the employers' needs and must be directed toward standards set for individual skill areas and recognized across employer and State lines; and

18 Whereas, the public must know exactly what they are getting for funds 19 appropriated; and

Whereas, the Apprenticeship Division of the Department of Labor should be expanded to prepare for the very necessary skilled training of North Carolina workers for the 21st century; Now, therefore,

23 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

## GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 2 Labor the sum of six hundred ninety-seven thousand eight hundred thirty-nine dollars 3 (\$697,839) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of seven hundred twenty-nine 4 thousand five hundred thirty-six dollars (\$729,536) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to 5 expand the Apprenticeship Division to provide training for 8,500 registered apprentices 6 by the end of the 1993-95 biennium. 7 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
