A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE AIRBORNE AND SPECIAL
OPERATIONS MUSEUM AT FORT BRAGG.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Airborne and Special Operations Museum Foundation, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to build and equip the Airborne and Special Operations Museum on Fort Bragg property. The museum will serve as a tribute to the United States Army Airborne and Special Operations Forces and will include exhibit space, a theater, an artifact preservation facility, a comprehensive military research library, a World War II vintage building complex, a gift shop and book store, a food court, and administrative space.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
