- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Airborne and 5 Special Operations Museum Foundation, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of eight 6 million dollars (\$8,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to build and equip the Airborne 7 and Special Operations Museum on Fort Bragg property. The museum will serve as a 8 tribute to the United States Army Airborne and Special Operations Forces and will 9 include exhibit space, a theater, an artifact preservation facility, a comprehensive 10 military research library, a World War II vintage building complex, a gift shop and book 11 store, a food court, and administrative space. 12 13

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
