17 18 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PAMLICO COUNTY WATER EROSION CONTROL PROJECT AND TO DRAW DOWN FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THIS PROJECT.

Whereas, the Corps of Engineers project in the Town of Oriental, Pamlico County, provides for installation of approximately 1,000 feet of steel bulkhead to protect a section of South Avenue in the Town of Oriental from being undermined by water erosion, and also provides for the installation of an asphalt sidewalk and a hand/guard rail along the bulkhead; and

Whereas, if the State does not appropriate matching funds for this project, then over \$400,000 in federal funds will not be available; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Water Resources, the sum of ninety-one thousand three hundred thirty-three dollars (\$91,333) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to match federal funds for the Corps of Engineers bulkhead project in the Town of Oriental.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
