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2	AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHILD FATALITY
3	TASK FORCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CHILD MALTREATMENT
4	EVALUATION AND EDUCATION CENTERS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
7	Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of —- for the 1993-94 fiscal
8	year and the sum of — for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to provide funding for contracts to
9	establish up to 12 child maltreatment and education centers, in order to make
10	comprehensive, multidisciplinary medical and mental health evaluations available to all
11	North Carolina's children.
12	Sec. 2. (a) Contracts let pursuant to this act shall ensure that the centers
13	established by funding by this act provide:
14	(1) A mechanism for providing systematic continuing education to health
15	care providers, social workers, and others involved in the evaluation of
16	children, to assure that they are up-to-date with the best possible
17	information; and
18	(2) A mechanism for providing similar instruction to individuals in
19	training, such as medical students, to increase the pool of professionals
20	available to provide evaluations.
21	(b) The contracting process shall also ensure that designated centers are
22	available throughout the State to support the capacity of examiners to conduct
23	multidisciplinary evaluations, where all the following services can be provided:
24	(1) Special equipment;

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1	(2) Interviewing/multidisciplinary back-up for physicians not affiliated
2	with a center;
3	(3) Second opinions;
4	(4) Availability for court proceedings; and
5	(5) Primary evaluations for children who live in the area served by the
6	center or for whom other health care providers are not available.
7	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
