2	AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE RULE-MAKING AUTHORITY OF THE MEDICAL
3	CARE COMMISSION FOR NURSING HOME REGULATION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 131E-116 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 131E-116. Definitions.
7	As used in this Part, unless otherwise specified:
8	(1) 'Administrator' means an administrator of a facility.
9	(1a) <u>'Commission' means the North Carolina Medical Care Commission.</u>
10	(2) 'Facility' means a nursing home and a home for the aged or disabled
11	licensed pursuant to G.S. 131E-102, and also means a nursing home
12	operated by a hospital which is licensed under Article 5 of G.S.
13	Chapter 131E.
14	(3) 'Patient' means a person who has been admitted to a facility.
15	(4) 'Representative payee' means a person certified by the federal
16	government to receive and disburse benefits for a recipient of
17	governmental assistance."
18	Sec. 2. Part B of Article 6 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is
19	amended by adding a new section to read:
20	" <u>§ 131E-131. Rule-making authority; enforcement.</u>
21	The Commission shall adopt rules necessary for the implementation of this Part.
22	The Department shall enforce the rules adopted by the Commission to implement
23	this Part."
24	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
