SENATE BILL 734

Short Title: Pilot Park Entrance Fees.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND
NATURAL RESOURCES TO PILOT THE COLLECTION OF ENTRANCE FEES
AT CERTAIN STATE PARKS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Division of Parks and Recreation of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall pilot the collection of entrance fees at Fort Fisher, Morrow Mountain, and Mt. Mitchell, beginning January 1, 1994. The Division shall file a written report with the General Assembly on the pilot program with findings and recommendations by the convening of the 1995 Regular Session of the General Assembly. The fees collected under this pilot program shall be deposited as receipts within the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources for use in the State Parks System. The pilot program shall terminate upon the filing of the report.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
