Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 7 8 Article to read: "ARTICLE 13. 9 "DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO AID OTHER COUNTRIES. 10 "§ 131E-231. Disposition of surplus property by public and State hospitals. 11 As used in this section, 'public hospital' has the same meaning as in G.S. 159-12 39. A State hospital is any hospital operated by the State. 13 A public hospital or a State hospital may donate medical equipment it 14 determines is no longer needed by the hospital to any: 15 Corporation which is exempt from taxation under section 501(c) of the 16 (1) Internal Revenue Code of 1986; 17 18 The United States or any agency thereof: (2) Government of a foreign country or any political subdivision of that 19 (3) country; or to 20 21 The United Nations or an agency of it (4) if the property so donated is to be used by a hospital or medical facility in another 22 23 country."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
