# 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT SOCIAL HOSTS PROVIDING ALCOHOLIC

3 BEVERAGES TO ADULT GUESTS SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES

- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Chapter 18B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 7 section to read:

## 8 "<u>§ 18B-309. No social host liability.</u>

A person, including a nonprofit corporation, who is a social host, and is either 9 (a) not required to obtain a permit under this Chapter, or has obtained a special occasion 10 permit or a limited special occasion permit, pursuant to G.S. 18B-207, for a special 11 occasion as defined in G.S. 18B-301(b), who provides alcoholic beverages to guests 21 12 years of age or older shall not be liable for any damages to adult guests or damages 13 caused by any adult guests who consumed the alcoholic beverages. 14 Subsection (a) of this section abrogates and abridges all claims for relief 15 (b)under the common law." 16

17 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
