"§ 163-166. Allocation of voting systems.  In allocating to precincts voting systems as defined in G.S. 163-160.1, the sol criteria shall be voter registration in the precinct."  Sec. 2. This act applies only to counties of 450,000 or more populatio according to the 1990 census.  Sec. 3. This act is effective with respect to elections conducted on or after	n

January 1, 1994.
