5	Section 1. G.S. 1340A-309.14 is amended by adding two new subsections to

7	"(a1) In order to promote the source reduction of waste, the Department of
8	Administration shall review and revise its bid procedures and specifications to
9	encourage the purchase or use of:
10	(1) <u>Reusable, refillable, repairable, more durable, and less toxic supplies</u>
11	and products and shall, to the extent practicable and cost-effective in
12	procuring supplies and products pursuant to Article 3 of Chapter 143
13	of the General Statutes, require the purchase or use of only such
14	supplies and products.
15	(2) <u>Remanufactured toner cartridges for laser printers and shall, to the</u>
16	extent practicable in procuring supplies and products pursuant to
17	Article 3 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, require the purchase
18	or use of only remanufactured toner cartridges for laser printers.
19	(a2) In order to promote the source reduction of waste, the Department of
20	Transportation shall review and revise its bid procedures and specifications to
21	encourage the purchase or use of reusable, refillable, repairable, more durable, and less
22	toxic supplies and products and shall, to the extent practicable and cost-effective in
23	procuring supplies and products pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 136 of the General
24	Statutes, require the purchase or use of only such supplies and products."
