The Department of Transportation shall require the purchase or use of such supplies and 13 14 products in the construction and maintenance of highways and bridges to the extent that the use is practicable and cost-effective. The 15 Department shall prepare an annual report on October 1 of each year to 16 17 the Environmental Review Commission as required under G.S. 130A-18 309.14(a1)."
 - Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994. The Department of Administration and the Department of Transportation shall prepare the first report to the Environmental Review Commission on October 1, 1994.

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
