BILL SUMMARY: Authorizes the Secretary of Administration to designate an employee of the Division of Purchase and Contract as minority business coordinator; requires that the GPAC General Fund Financial Model be incorporated by reference in the Current Operations Appropriations Act; authorizes the Secretary of Administration to prescribe rules governing purchases off contract; requires the Department of Administration to study the feasibility of consolidating the State Surplus Property Section with the Federal Surplus Property Section.
