The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 163-212 reads as rewritten:	
"§ 163-212. Penalty for failure of presidential elector to attend and vot	ie.
Any presidential elector having previously signified his consent to s	erve as such,
who fails to attend and vote for the candidate of the political party which	ch nominated
such elector, for President and Vice-President of the United States at the ti	me and place
directed in G.S. 163-210 (except in case of sickness or other unavoidable a	ccident) shall
forfeit and pay to the State five hundred dollars (\$500.00),ten thou	<u>ısand dollars</u>
(\$10,000), to be recovered by the Attorney General in the Superior Co	
County. In addition to such forfeiture, refusal or failure to vote for the can	
political party which nominated such elector shall constitute a resignat	
office of elector, his vote shall not be recorded, and the remaining	electors shall
forthwith fill such vacancy as hereinbefore provided.	
The clear proceeds of forfeitures provided for in this section shall be re-	emitted to the
Civil Penalty and Forfeiture Fund in accordance with G.S. 115C-457.2."	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
