A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF RALEIGH TO ALLOW  
3 THE CITY TO SELL PERSONAL UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT TO PUBLIC  
4 SAFETY EMPLOYEES UPON THE EMPLOYEES LEAVING THE CITY'S  
5 EMPLOYMENT.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 33(c) of the Charter of the City of Raleigh, being  
8 Chapter 1184 of the 1949 Sessions, as amended by S.L. 1991-312, S.L. 1993-649, and  
9 S.L. 1995-323, reads as rewritten:

10 "(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, nothing  
11 herein shall be construed as preventing any official or employee covered by this section  
12 from purchasing a utility service offered to the general public at uniform rates, sludge  
13 generated at a wastewater treatment plant, farm products grown on City-owned or  
14 City-leased farms, and mulch produced at the City's yard waste processing center. In  
15 addition to the transactions authorized in this section, the City may sell items of  
16 personal uniforms and equipment, excluding weapons, to public safety employees upon  
17 their separation from the City's employment. The items may be sold by private sale at  
18 the prices and under the terms and conditions that the City Council may establish by  
19 resolution."

20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
