AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF ENGINES USED TO POWER THE STATE'S MOTOR FLEET.

SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the different types of engines used to power the State's motor fleet. In conducting the study, the Commission may compare the fuel efficiency of vehicles powered by gas or diesel only and those powered by a combination of gas and electricity.

SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to the 2006 Regular Session of the 2005 General Assembly and shall make its final report to the 2007 General Assembly.

SECTION 3. The Legislative Services Officer shall allocate funds appropriated to the General Assembly for the expenditures of the Legislative Services Commission in conducting this study.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
