A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A FULL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT WHO  
2 ATTENDS A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF  
3 NORTH CAROLINA SHALL BE CONSIDERED AND TREATED FOR ALL  
4 PURPOSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AS A RESIDENT  
5 OF NORTH CAROLINA.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 14 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended  
8 by adding a new section to read:

9 **"§ 116-143.6. Full scholarship students attending constituent institutions.**

10 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any nonresident person who  
11 receives a full scholarship to a constituent institution and who attends the institution  
12 shall be considered and treated for all purposes of The University of North Carolina as a  
13 resident of North Carolina.

14 (b) The following definitions apply in this section:

- 15 (1) 'Full scholarship' means a grant that meets the full cost for a student to  
16 attend the constituent institution for an academic year.  
17 (2) 'Full cost' means an amount calculated by the constituent institution  
18 that is no less than the sum of in-State tuition, required fees,  
19 on-campus room and board, and required course-related books."  
20

21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to  
22 students who receive full scholarships on or after that date.
