6	SECTION 1. Section 1.1 of S.L. 2004-179, as amended by Section 30.3A of				
7	S.L. 2005-276, reads as rewritten:				
8	"SECTION 1.1. In accordance with G.S. 142-83, this section authorizes the				
9	issuance or incurrence of special indebtedness in the following maximum aggregate				
10	principal amounts to finance the costs of the following projects. The table below				
11	provides the maximum principal amounts. The first column is the aggregate maximum				
12	principal amount. The second column is the maximum portion of this amount that can				
13	be issued or incurred before July 1, 2005. The State, with the prior approval of the State				
14	Treasurer and the Council of State, as provided in Article 9 of Chapter 142 of the				
15	General Statutes, is authorized to issue or incur special indebtedness in order to provide				
16	funds to the State to be used, together with other available funds, to pay the cost of these				
17	projects.	-
