A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE 3 FOR THE ONE NORTH CAROLINA SMALL BUSINESS ACCOUNT AND TO 4 APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF SCIENCE 5 AND TECHNOLOGY TO STUDY THE ROLE OF INNOVATION-BASED ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESSES IN THE STATE. 6

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 9 10 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the One North Carolina Small Business 11 Account to provide grants under the North Carolina SBIR/STTR Incentive Program and to provide matching grants under the North Carolina SBIR/STTR Matching Funds 12 13 Program.

14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for 15 16 the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Board of Science and 17 Technology for the purpose of conducting a study to determine the role of innovation-based entrepreneurial businesses in the State's economy and to recommend 18 strategies for promoting the growth of these businesses. In conducting the study, the 19 20 Board shall consider all relevant issues, including capital formation and technology The Board shall establish an advisory committee of individuals from 21 transfer. 22 innovation-based entrepreneurial businesses to assist the Board in collecting and 23 interpreting information.
