G.S. 15A-1340.16(d)(6) reads as rewritten: Aggravating Factors. – The following are aggravating factors:
	(6) The offense was committed against or proximately caused serious injury to a present or former law enforcement officer, employee of the Department of Correction, jailer, fireman, emergency medical technician, ambulance attendant, social worker, justice or judge, clerk or assistant or deputy clerk of court, magistrate, prosecutor, juror, or witness against the defendant, while engaged in the performance of that person's official duties or because of the exercise of that person's official duties."  SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
