school bus route as ordained by the Division of Highways, that the school bus, to which	ch
such pupil is assigned, shall pass within one mile of the residence of each pupil, wh	ho
lives one and one half miles or more from the school to which such pupil is assigned."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
