The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-246(b) reads as rewritten:	
"(b) Unless road or other conditions shall make it inadvisable t	t o do so,
inadvisable, public school buses shall be so routed on state-maintained	highways
highways, municipal streets, or other streets with publicly dedicated right-of	-way. that
the school bus, to which such pupil is assigned, shall pass within one m	ile of the
residence of each pupil, who lives one and one half miles or more from the	school to
which such pupil is assigned. Each public school bus shall be routed so th	at the bus
passes within one mile of the residence of each pupil assigned to that bus. A	pupil who
lives one and one-half miles or more from the school to which the pupil is assi	gned shall
be eligible for school bus transportation."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
