5		<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 1 of Chapter 75 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a	new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 75-40</u>	. Prohibit maintenance fees for gift cards.
8	<u>(a)</u>	No person, firm, or corporation engaged in commerce shall charge a
9	<u>maintena</u>	ance fee on a gift card.
10	<u>(b)</u>	Any violation of this section shall be punishable by the imposition of a civil
11		of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each violation. A violation of this section is
12	<u>an unfair</u>	trade practice under G.S. 75-1.1.
13	<u>(c)</u>	Definitions. – As used in this section, the following definitions apply:
14		(1) <u>'Gift card' means a record evidencing a promise, made for monetary</u>
15		consideration, by a seller or issuer that goods or services will be
16		provided to the owner of the record to the value shown in the record. A
17		'gift card' includes, but is not limited to, a record that contains a
18		microprocessor chip, magnetic strip, or other storage medium that is
19		pre-funded and for which the value is adjusted upon each use, a gift
20		certificate, a stored-value card or certificate, a store card, or a prepaid
21		long-distance telephone service that is activated by a prepaid card that
22		required dialing an access number or an access code in addition to
23		dialing the phone number to which the user of the prepaid card seeks
24		to connect.
25		(2) 'Maintenance fee' means any fee that the owner of the gift card is
26		subject to when the gift card is redeemed, including a service or
27		inactivity fee."

1 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and applies to gift 2 cards as defined in G.S. 75-40, as enacted by Section 1 of this act, that are sold on or

3 after that date.
