A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE CONSPICUOUS DISCLOSURE OF AN MAINTENANCE FEES CHARGED FOR GIFT CARDS AND TO PROHIBI ISSUERS OF GIFT CARDS FROM CHARGING MAINTENANCE FEES FO ONE YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF PURCHASE.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. Article 13 of Chapter 66 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:
"§ 66-67.4. Requirements for maintenance fees for gift cards.
(a) <u>Disclosure. – The seller or issuer of a gift card must conspicuously disclosure</u> any maintenance fee charges at the time of purchase. The disclosure must be visible of
the gift card itself. No person, firm, or corporation engaged in commerce shall charge any maintenance fee on a gift card for one calendar year following the date of the purchase of the gift card.
(b) Penalty. – A seller or issuer of a gift card who violates this section commi
an unfair trade practice under G.S. 75-1.1 and is subject to a civil penalty in accordance
with G.S. 75-15.2.
(c) <u>Definitions. – As used in this section, the following terms mean:</u>
(1) Gift card. – A record evidencing a promise, made for monetar
consideration, by a seller or issuer that goods or services will be provided to the owner of the record to the value shown in the record.
