BILL SUMMARY: Amends GS 136-18(2) to authorize the Department of Transportation to acquire rights-of-way for local or relocation of broadband communications lines for utilities or governmental entities

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The bill adds "broadband communications" to a list that would read "...telephone, telegraph, <u>broadband communications</u>, electric and other lines, as well as gas, water, sewerage, oil and other pipelines to be operated by public utilities as defined in G.S. 62-3(23)..."

According to the Department of Transportation, the Department's policy is to treat broadband communications in the same manner as the other industries named in the statute. Therefore the bill would not have a fiscal impact on DOT.
