5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
6	SECTION 1. Article 7 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by	
7	adding a new section to read:	
8	" <u>§ 136-102.8. Subdivision streets; traffic calming devices.</u>	
9	The Department shall not prohibit the installation or utilization of traffic tables or traffic	
10	calming devices erected on State-maintained subdivision streets adopted by the Department,	
11	pursuant to G.S. 136-102.6, so long as the installation and utilization is within the subdivision	
12	and the traffic tables or traffic calming devices are paid for and maintained by a homeowner's	
13	association."	
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to traffic	
15	calming devices or traffic tables installed on or after that date.
