| 3 | Whereas, the House of Flags Museum opened on September 8, 2001, in a temporary |
| 4 | facility in Green Creek, North Carolina; and |
| 5 | Whereas, the House of Flags Museum has a collection of over 300 national, |
| 6 | international, state, military, and religious flags, including 27 full-size official United States |
| 7 | flags from 1776 to 1960; and |
| 8 | Whereas, the Museum's mission is to provide a unique tourist destination in North |
| 9 | Carolina dedicated to nurturing and promoting patriotism, flag etiquette, and historical |
| 10 | understanding of the evolution of our nation's flag through flag displays and a variety of |
| 11 | education programs and activities for all visitors; and |
| 12 | Whereas, Museum visitors can take guided or self-guided tours or watch educational |
| 13 | videos to learn about the flags in the collection, all of which were donated by local veterans, |
| 14 | citizens, visitors, or purchased through donations; and |
| 15 | Whereas, plans have been made to establish a permanent facility to house the House |
| 16 | of Flags Museum in Columbus, North Carolina; and |
| 17 | Whereas, the House of Flags Museum was founded by George Scofield and the |
| 18 | members of the VFW Post 9116; and |
| 19 | Whereas, George Scofield worked tirelessly to instill patriotism in the younger |
| 20 | generations and was widely known for using the phrase "31 Words, Three Commas," which he |
| 21 | used to refer to the Pledge of Allegiance; and |
| 22 | Whereas, George Scofield served as the curator of the Museum prior to his death on |
| 23 | November 25, 2008; Now, therefore, |
| 24 | Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring: |
| 25 | SECTION 1. The General Assembly expresses its support for the House of Flags |
| 26 | Museum in its efforts to promote patriotism and tourism in the State. |
| 27 | SECTION 2. The General Assembly honors the life and memory of George |
| 28 | Scofield and expresses its appreciation for the service he rendered to his community, State, and |
| 29 | nation, including founding the House of Flags Museum. |
| 30 | SECTION 2. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this |
| 31 | resolution to the House of Flags Museum. |
| 32 | SECTION 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification. |
