SESSION LAW 2009-324 HOUSE BILL 385

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE GRAHAM COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO PERMIT THE USE OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ACTIVITY BUSES TO SERVE THE TRANSPORTATION NEEDS OF THE STECOAH VALLEY CENTER DURING PERIODIC FIELD TRIPS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 66-58 or any other provision of law, the Graham County Board of Education may enter into a contract, under terms and conditions set by the Graham County Board of Education, to permit public school activity buses to be used by the Stecoah Valley Center for periodic after-school field trip activities.

State funds shall not be used for the use and operation of buses under this act.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 23rd day of July, 2009.
