A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT DESIGNATING APRIL AS WOODWORKING MONTH IN NORTH CAROLINA. 3 Whereas, the month of April is celebrated as National Woodworking Month; and 4 Whereas, designating the month of April as Woodworking Month in North Carolina 5 would help focus attention on the beauty and satisfaction of working with wood; and Whereas, the designation would motivate North Carolinians to undertake 6 7 woodworking projects by increasing their knowledge and skill in woodworking and wood 8 finishing; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 9 SECTION 1. Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 10 11 section to read: 12 "§ 103-12. Woodworking Month. The month of April of each year is designated as Woodworking Month in the State of North 13 14 Carolina."

15 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
