1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATELY RECOGNIZE THE NATIONAL GUARD AND TO 3 CREATE UNIFORMITY IN THE SPELLING OF THE TERM "NATIONAL GUARD" 4 WHEREVER IT APPEARS IN THE GENERAL STATUTES BY CAPITALIZING IT, AS 5 RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT STUDY COMMITTEE ON MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 6 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. The Revisor of Statutes shall modify the term "national guard" 8 wherever it appears in the General Statutes so that both the word "National" and the word 9 "Guard" are capitalized. 10 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 11
