SENATE BILL 539

Short Title: Greensboro Motor Vehicle Levy. (Local)

Sponsors: Senators Dorsett; and Vaughan.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF GREENSBORO TO INCREASE ITS MOTOR
3 VEHICLE TAX BY UP TO AN ADDITIONAL SIX DOLLARS PER YEAR.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 31 of the 1991 Session Laws is repealed. That act authorized
6 the City of Greensboro to levy, in addition to up to five dollars (\$5.00) per year for general
7 purposes, an additional motor vehicle tax of up to five dollars (\$5.00) per year for local public
8 transportation purposes.

9 **SECTION 2.(a)** G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:

10 "(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not more than
11 ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ sixteen dollars (\$16.00) per year upon any vehicle resident in the city or
12 town. The proceeds of the tax up to five dollars (\$5.00) may be used for any lawful purpose.
13 The proceeds of these taxes derived from any levy above five dollars (\$5.00) and up to sixteen
14 dollars (\$16.00) shall be used exclusively for local public transportation purposes."

15 **SECTION 2.(b)** This section applies to the City of Greensboro only.

16 **SECTION 3.** Section 1 of this act is effective upon the date the City of Greensboro
17 acts to levy a tax under Section 2 of the act.

18 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
