	Whereas, Bethesda Presbyterian Church, located in southern Moore County, North
	rolina, was instrumental in the development of the community and the only church to serve
the	e community for the first 100 years of its existence; and
	Whereas, in 1756, the Synod of Philadelphia sent the Reverend James Campbell, a
	aelic preacher, to serve the Highland Scots who had settled in the area of the lower Cape Fear
	sin, beginning a tradition of establishing different preaching points throughout the region;

~	Whereas, the first settlers gathered under brush arbors at the head of the Rockfish
Cr	eek, and a regular community of worshippers was established; and
	Whereas, in 1788, the first solid structure was built on property that had been
de	eded to James Patterson by King George of England in 1766; and
	Whereas, in 1832, a second building was built adjacent to the Pee Dee Road, a
	ajor roadway for the area's commercial trade in the community now known as Blue's
Cr	ossing; and
a1a	Whereas, in 1862, a third building was built on the same property, with a gallery for
	aves and separate entrances for men and women, even in the midst of the hardship and strife a Civil War; and
01	Whereas, in 1907, a fourth building was built in the town proper, by now renamed
۸1	berdeen, so that the worshippers could have access to electricity and be in a location more
	ntrally located to its parishioners; and
	Whereas, in 1923, the members decided to institute the tradition of an annual
ho	mecoming at the previous location in order to preserve the history and structure of the old
	urch building; and
