Referred to: Appropriations. February 21, 2013 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RENOVATE THE FORMER COHARIE INDIAN SCHOOL BUILDING IN SAMPSON COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Coharie Intra Tribal Council, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2013-2014 fiscal year to renovate the Sampson County building that was originally used as a school for the Coharie Indians and other Native Americans from Bladen, Cumberland, Duplin, Harnett, and Sampson Counties. **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
