5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
6	SECTION 1. Part 7 of Article 50 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended				
7	by adding a new section to read:				
8	"§ 58-50-295. Prohibited contract provisions related to reimbursement rates.				
9	No contract with a health care provider shall do any of the following:				
10	<u>(1)</u>	Prohibit, or grant a health insurance carrier an option to prohibit, the			
11		provider from contracting with another health insurance carrier to provide			
12		health care services at a rate that is equal to or lower than the payment			
13		specified in the contract.			
14	<u>(2)</u>	Require the provider to accept a lower payment rate in the event that the			
15		provider agrees to provide health care services to any other health insurance			
16		carrier at a rate that is equal to or lower than the payment specified in the			
17		contract.			
18	<u>(3)</u>	Require, or grant a health insurance carrier an option to require, termination			
19		or renegotiation of an existing health care contract in the event that the			
20		provider agrees to provide health care services to any other health insurance			
21		carrier at a rate that is equal to or lower than the payment specified in the			
22		contract.			
23	<u>(4)</u>	Require, or grant a health insurance carrier an option to require, the provider			
24		to disclose, directly or indirectly, the provider's contractual rates with			
25		another health insurance carrier.			
26	<u>(5)</u>	Require, or grant a health insurance carrier an option to require, the			
27		nonnegotiated adjustment by the issuer of the provider's contractual rate to			
28		equal the lowest rate the provider has agreed to charge any other health			
29		insurance carrier.			
30	<u>(6)</u>	Require, or grant a health insurance carrier an option to require, the provider			
31		to charge another health insurance carrier a rate that is equal to or more than the mimburgement rate englished in the contract "			
32 33	SECT	the reimbursement rate specified in the contract."			
33 34	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2013, and applies to contracts ontered into remended on or after that data				
34	entered into, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
