6	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-269.4 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:	
7	" <u>(7)</u> <u>Any po</u>	erson who is an elected or appointed clerk of court while the person is
8	discharging his or her official duties, provided all of the following criteria	
9	are sat	isfied:
10	<u>a.</u>	The weapon is a handgun.
11	<u>b.</u>	The person (i) has a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance
12		with Article 54B of this Chapter or considered valid under
13		G.S. 14-415.24, (ii) has been certified under applicable law as having
14		completed a basic law enforcement training course as defined in
15		Chapter 17C or Chapter 17E of the General Statutes, or (iii) has
16		successfully completed a one-time weapons retention training
17		substantially similar to that provided to certified law enforcement
18		officers in North Carolina.
19	<u>c.</u>	The person secures the handgun in a locked compartment when the
20		handgun is not on his or her person."
21	SECTION 2.	This act becomes effective December 1, 2013.
